(SEPTEMBER 14, 2017)

Called to order 8:05 PM

Motion to accept July minutes approved and seconded.

Movies at the Park: Thank you John!!!

Lamtec donated \$2,000 for this event. Only used \$1,000.

The remainder will go into the general fund.

Marty Pinter brought kids games.

We had 100-150 kids attend.

Next year we will have 3...we already have promised donation for all 3 movies.

Over budget by \$600...we forgot to include the price of admission into the event...oops.
